Join Supplementary School in Nursery

Each stage up to stage 5 is 1 year in duration except the Hifz & Youth classes which vary in duration.

Nursery *(aged 5-6 years- day school year 1)*

Reception A *(aged 6-7 years- day school year 2)*

Reception B *(aged 7-8 years- day school year 3)*

Stage 1 *(aged 8-9 years- day school year 4)*

Hifz class for boys and girls

(aged 8 years and above - day school year 4 and above-must meet set conditions prior to joining)

Stage 2a *(aged 9-10 years- day school year 5)*

Stage 2b *(aged 10-11 years- day school year 6)*

Stage 3a *(aged 11-12 years- day school year 7)*

Stage 3b *(aged 12-13 years- day school year 8)*

Stage 4a *(aged 13-14 years- day school year 9)*

Stage 4b *(aged 14-15 years- day school year 10)*

Stage 5 *(aged 15-16 years- day school year 11)*

Youth class *(aged 16-20 years)*

Join Khizra Mosque boys and girls youth teams.

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Subjects taught at the supplementary school include Quran recitation, Hifz of the Quran, Islamic studies, Arabic and lots of extracurricular activities.

Student must have completed Qaida to be able to proceed to any of the classes from Reception B & above on weekdays.
